








Grandma's German Apple Cake Recipe

- 2 cups flour
- 1 cup sugar
- 2 ½ tsp baking powder
- ½ tsp salt
- ½ cup softened butter (or crisco) + some for pan
- 6 tbsp water
- 3 eggs
- 1 tsp vanilla

Mix all ingredients in a bowl.

Use lasagna pan or 2 cake pans – use paper towel to spread butter or crisco in bottom of pan – add the batter and spread to edges.

 4 apples – skin and cut into slices.

Add apples to top of cake batter.

Topping:

- 1/2 cup sugar
- 3 tbsp flour
- 3 tbsp soft butter
- Cinnamon

Mix together and rub with fingers into sandy crumbs. Sprinkle on top.
